



OVERNIGHTS AT REDWOOD



Redwood is offering **optional overnights for campers, boys and girls, completing grades 1 to 5**. This is an ideal *sleep-away* adventure for children who, during their stay at camp, would like to try only one overnight per week.

Accommodations and Staff: The overnight building is fully screened and is equipped with bathrooms/showers, a kitchen and dining area, and enough bunk beds to accommodate 14 campers and 3 senior staff members. **Please take note, there is no registered nurse on site during the overnight.**

Dates: Offered Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and occasionally Mondays. Overnights may be co-ed and subject to change. We will be in touch with you closer to camp to give you the exact date.

Reservations: In order to confirm a reservation, you must complete the overnight form and enclose full payment. Overnights are on a first come basis and are subject to availability.

When completing your form: Please state any medical concerns, medication that your child is taking at home or anything that would be pertinent to make your child's stay a safe one.

Cost: \$85.00 per overnight. For campers on the lunch program, please deduct \$10 per overnight.

MORE INFO ON OVERNIGHTS

Meals: Redwood provides all meals. Supper can include hot dogs, hamburgers, mac 'n'cheese, grilled cheese, vegetables, fruit and juice. Snacks may consist of fruit cups, pudding, cookies, chips, popcorn, marshmallows and hot chocolate. Breakfast includes pancakes, toast, fruit, milk and juice. The lunch for the following day is supplied by Redwood's lunch program and will vary depending on the day. If your child has any food allergies, restrictions, or if you would like to provide your own meals, it is important that you call the office to discuss and review the food items.

What to bring: Sleeping bag, pillow, towel, face cloth, pyjamas, extra bathing suit, sweat pants, sweat shirt, extra underwear, socks, raincoat, hair brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, sunscreen, insect repellent, flashlight and flip-flops (recommended for bathroom), all in a separate overnight bag from their usual camp bag.

Phone: The office will only be open until 6:00 P.M. to answer phone calls. Messages will be checked the following morning. If there is an urgent message, please leave it on the voice mail and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

Cancellations: There are no refunds for cancellations.
